ABSTRACT

Hittites, one of the major civilizations in middle east, established the first state organization in the center Anatolia. This is dominated by a strong state to a lesser extent at the regional administrative structures in Anatolia. This is part of the administrative structures were located in the western Anatolia. Western Anatolia at the same time, the Hittite Empire and the great struggle between Ahhiyawa and Arzawa Countries inhabited area. Although the purposes of the Hittites settled in this region indirectly calling to us to maintain dominance. Ahhiyawa and tried to break the power of Arzawa from time to time Hittites felt in the region. Much smaller than the governments in the region to keep their kingdom is sometimes Ahhiyawa sometimes Hittite or sometimes sided with the Kingdom of Arzawa.
