ABSTRACT

OBSERVATION OF MORFOLOGICAL AND SOME ECOLOGICAL FEATURES OF Montivipera xanthina (Gray, 1849) (Ophidia: Viperidae) INDIVIDUALS IN LABORATORY

Montivipera xanthina is distributed in Aegean, Western Mediterranean and Western Central Anatolia. There is no detailed and comprehensive study about this species in Turkey. This species was studied generally in herpetofaunal studies or venom analayzes. M. xanthina is a monotypic species. Populations of this taxon are separeted hipoteticly as north and south in terms of morphological characters, but this data is not enough for identified as subspecies.
